Convenient shuttle services between Santa Fe locations and Albuquerque International Airport, with 30 trips daily to fit your travel schedule. Pick up and drop off at many hotels, motels, bed and breakfasts, colleges, and other locations in Santa Fe, NM.

The check-in desk in the ABQ Sunport is conveniently located inside the terminal building on the baggage claim level. Please be sure to check in there for your shuttle.

Rates: One way \$33 per person

Parking

The La Posada parking fee has been discounted to \$10 per vehicle per day. The charges may appear on your confirmation letter however the correct fees will be noted upon arrival at the hotel.

Parking can be tight in Santa Fe, though many attractions are within walking distance of downtown hotels. There are convenient city-owned parking lots in the downtown area and many meters available for one or two hours only that cost \$1.00 per hour.

Using the shuttle services may be a better option than renting a car.

Santa Fe Local Transportation

There is city-wide taxi service and a public bus system, [Santa Fe Trails](#), that serves the city with six routes, including the free [Santa Fe Pickup Shuttle](#). Buses operate from 6:30 a.m. to 5:30 p.m., Monday through Friday, and from 8:30 a.m. to 5:30 p.m. on Saturdays and 10:00 a.m. to 5:30pm Sundays. Schedules are available on each bus, at libraries and at locations throughout the city. For schedule, rate and fare information, call 505-9552001. The Santa Fe Pick-Up shuttle service is a fast, free way to get around downtown, Museum Hill and Canyon Road.

Weather and Climate in Santa Fe

The climate in Santa Fe can change rapidly and often. It can often be cooler than visitors expect, so please plan accordingly. Be sure to check current conditions before traveling as rains can quickly cool down a hot day and bring unexpected rapid humidity. [Click here for the 7-day forecast](#)

- Santa Fe's high altitude (7,000 feet above sea level) means air is rarefied, thinner. It usually takes about 48 hours to adjust and staying hydrated helps.
- Watch your alcohol intake. One drink is the equivalent of three at sea level.
- Use sunscreen and wear a hat. There are no beaches, but Santa Fe is closer to the sun, and the sun shines 300 days of the year.
- Santa Fe's climate is dry, with sometimes less than 20 percent humidity
- The winds here in New Mexico do pick up in the spring so don't forget a lightweight jacket/coat. It also can become a bit chilly in the evenings **so make sure to pack some warm layers.**
