ECL2 clients using Q-Pulse include 73 percent of the Organ Procurement Organizations across the United States, 35 of these organizations are accredited with AATB. Additionally, ECL2 provides software (quality, risk and safety) to numerous tissue processors, healthcare organizations, a wide variety of labs as well as government institutions.
